MINIMUM WAGE INCREASE

Starting July 1, 2007 Illinois businesses are required to pay workers at least \$7.50 per hour, followed by three \$.25 increases: \$7.75 on July 1, 2008, \$8.00 on July 1, 2009, and \$8.25 on July 1, 2010. The Illinois Chamber of Commerce is offering sets of employment postings for \$45. Please call 866-817-7865.
